	Alliance, a national association of land trusts. Since 2011 Gathering Waters has provided LEAP assistance to over 30 land trusts
	across Wisconsin. During 2019 Gathering Waters organized a statewide conference for conservation organizations attended by
	approximately 100 participants. In addition, during 2019 Gathering Waters initiated "Land Trust Days," an effort to promote

Gathering Waters maintains an interactive website and publishes paper and electronic newsletters throughout the year. In addition, Gathering Waters organized an awards celebration to honor significant contributions made by leaders in land conservation that drew over 200 attendees. Code: (Expenses \$ 155,403 including grants of \$ 1,000) (Revenue \$ 0.) Policy and government relations: work with decision makers at all levels of government to promote state, local, and federal policies that support the work of land trusts and the conservation of private land. Specifically, Gathering Waters advocates for continuation of funding for the Knowles Nelson Stewardship Fund, a program of public financial support for the preservation of land in Wisconsin. Partly as a result of this effort in 2019 the state of Wisconsin renewed the Stewardship Fund for another two years and provided funding of \$66 million for land and water conservation.
