Wisconsin Conservation Circle Frequently Asked Questions

Q. How do I join the Wisconsin Conservation Circle?

A. It's easy. Simply approve a fixed monthly gift from your credit card, debit card, or an ACH transfer from your bank account to Gathering Waters. It's convenient, and you'll know that your gift works to help protect land, water, and wildlife in Wisconsin.

Q. Is my payment information safe?

A. Absolutely! Any payment information you supply online is secure; look for the padlock symbol or "https" in the URL address of your browser. We store your payment information in our files and do not share it with anyone.

Q. How do I change my monthly gift?

A. You can change the amount of your monthly gift any time by:

Q. How will I keep records of my monthly gifts?

A. Your monthly credit card or bank statement will show the date and the amount of your gift to Gathering Waters.

A. Yes, definitely! You will receive regular updates about land and water protection in Wisconsin. You'll also receive invitations for events in your area.

Q. How do I start my monthly gift and join the Wisconsin Conservation Circle?

A. You can complete the reply card in this mailing, visit gatheringwaters.org/WCC and complete the online donation form, or call Pat at 608-251-9131 ext. 14 and she will manually enter your credit card information. Once you make a monthly pledge, you're a member of the Wisconsin Conservation Circle. (Please note, if you're mailing in an approval for an ACH transfer, you'll need to include a copy of a voided check.)
